The map to the right provides the status of countywide hazard mitigation plans for the State of Illinois. The top 10 most populous jurisdictions are also included. These jurisdictions may have their own, single-jurisdiction hazard mitigation plan or may participate in the countywide hazard mitigation plan for which the jurisdiction lies.

BI-MONTHLY HIGHLIGHTS

82.8% of the Illinois population is covered by an Approved or Approvable Pending Adoption plan. This includes nine out of the 18 counties (and one city) that received a planning grant under the Illinois HMP Grant Program (PoP ends 06/30/20).

The 2020 Illinois Mitigation Consultation was completed on September 30, 2020. Due to the impacts of COVID-19, the event was held virtually. IEMA expressed the need to improve and expand its current practices to build a more effective mitigation program. To do this, IEMA utilized the Consultation to understand what other states' mitigation programs are doing to gain perspective and best practices. The two-hour panel discussion provided an opportunity for IEMA to ask questions to other state officials and learn from their experiences. IEMA will use the learnings from the Consultation to make more informed decisions regarding improvements to their mitigation program to support communities before, during, and after a disaster.
